SUBJECT: Mask Expectations

As always, your safety and well-being is Phi Mu's primary concern and we must continue to take precautions regarding COVID-19 and the delta variant.

It is the Fraternity's expectation that chapters follow the recommendations of the [CDC](#). Currently, the CDC recommends that masks be worn indoors and the Fraternity is asking you to follow those guidelines. I want each one of you, and every one of our members, to default to what is the safest possible decision when interacting as a chapter, with your sisters and while on campus!

If your campus and/or local Panhellenic mandates masks, we count on your chapter to cooperate and follow that directive. The Fraternity expects our chapters and members to support those decisions. If your campus and/or local Panhellenic has not made such a mandate, we expect you to follow CDC guidelines. Be respectful of members and Potential New Members who choose to wear a mask. Additionally, if your chapter or house corporation decides to mandate masks, the Fraternity fully supports that decision.

For housed chapters, all members are expected to abide by the [Sisterhood Pledge](#).
