- Consideration of other extracurricular activities and dedication to the ideals of Phi Mu.

Outstanding Collegiate Member for Service to Phi Mu Award / 1 Honorable Mention

The Fraternity honors one collegiate member who has excelled in her chapter. This award honors a member who has excelled in her contribution to the excellence of Phi Mu.

Criteria:

- Initiated collegian in good standing.
- Demonstrates excellence in the following areas:
 - Dedication to the ideals of Phi Mu
 - Chapter involvement
 - Scholarship
 - Campus involvement
 - Community service
- Other extracurricular activities

- Consideration of other extracurricular activities and dedication to Phi Mu ideals.
- Must have served on the Executive Committee or chaired at least one committee.
- Must have made unique contributions to the chapter whether an improvement or contribution to the overall life of the chapter.
- Support for chapter activities.
