### **100% Alumnae Chapter Reporting / Multiple Recipients**

Awarded to alumnae chapters that remit all reports by dues dates for both years of the biennium.

### **CMN Financial Support / Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter with largest financial support for Children's Miracle Network.

*Judged by:* CMN Statistics

### **CMN Fundraising Improvement Award / Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter with largest growth in financial support for Children's Miracle Network.

*Judged by:* CMN Statistics

### **Founders Circle / Multiple Recipients**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter that operates well throughout the biennium as shown through membership retention, sisterhood programming, service and public relations.

*Judged by:* Headquarters Statistics; Director of Lifetime Engagement

### **Forever Faithful Membership Award / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter with the highest percentage of participation in Forever Faithful or to all chapters with 100% participation. 2025-2026 fiscal year statistics will be used to determine this award. Forever Faithful dues must be paid by June 1, 2026, to qualify.

**Alumnae Ritual / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the chapter that makes use of services when appropriate and includes Ritual within alumnae chapter programming such as workshops, Founders Day, etc.

**Heart to Heart / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter offering the greatest support to its assigned long-distance or local collegiate chapter(s).

**Innovative Alumnae Membership Recruitment and Retention / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter that utilizes innovative and consistent membership recruitment and retention techniques to generate new members, retain existing members and increase local alumnae participation.

**Most Unique Philanthropic Fundraiser / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the chapter that has hosted the most creative and unique fundraiser in support of Phi Mu Foundation.

*Criteria:*

- (1) Demonstrates excellence in the following areas:
  - a. Event planning and preparation
  - b. Public relations
  - c. Local community and/or campus impact
- (2) Must submit the following information within submission:
  - a. Description of what makes the event unique
  - b. Whether philanthropy submission is new fundraiser or annual event

**Outstanding Alumnae Chapter Newsletter / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter that produces the best newsletter or e-newsletter.

### **Outstanding Alumnae Public Relations / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter that positively and creatively promotes Phi Mu while communicating with chapter members, local alumnae and the greater community. In addition to local events, the chapter celebrates Fraternity news and events.

### **Outstanding Alumnae Social Media Presence / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter that successfully and regularly utilizes social media to engage members, promote local events and also serve as loyal Phi Mu Brand Ambassadors during Fraternity campaigns (such as Founders Day, Phi Mu Night Out, Forever Faithful, etc.).

### **Outstanding Philanthropic Chapter / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to an alumnae chapter that demonstrates tremendous philanthropic leadership and dedication through advancing and supporting Phi Mu Foundation.

*Criteria:*

- (1) Demonstrates philanthropic leadership in local community and in Phi Mu
- (2) Must submit the following information within submission:
  - a. Description of chapter's commitment to Phi Mu Foundation
  - b. Description of positive impact of chapter's philanthropy on members and community

### **Phi Mu Day / Multiple Recipients**

Awarded to chapters that have hosted an outstanding Phi Mu Day during the biennium.

### **Sisterhood Achievement / 1 Honorable Mention**

Awarded to the alumnae chapter that exhibits the best overall programming that fosters sisterhood development and appreciation for lifelong Fraternity membership among alumnae members.

There are three Outstanding Alumna Achievement awards that have been presented by the Fraternity since the 1980-1982 biennium to outstanding alumnae in recognition of their contribution to community, profession or Phi Mu. An individual may be nominated for more than one category; however, she will not receive an award in more than one category. The same application may not be used for multiple awards and no anonymous nominations will be accepted. Nominations may be submitted by individual Phi Mus, collegiate chapters or alumnae chapters by using the Google Form link.

### [Outstanding Alumna Achievement Award for Contribution to Community](#)

Criteria:

- (1) Actively participates in community organizations
- (2) Holds office in community or service organizations at the local, state or national level
- (3) Has maintained her support of Phi Mu Fraternity
- (4) Letter of support required

### [Outstanding Alumna Achievement Award for Contribution to Profession](#)

Criteria:

- (1) Has been recognized for achievements within the profession by her peers
- (2) Actively participates in community organizations
- (3) Actively participates in professional organizations
- (4) Holds office in professional and community organizations
- (5) Has maintained her support of Phi Mu Fraternity

- (6) Letter of support required

*Judged by:* National Council

**Outstanding Alumna Achievement Award for Contribution to Phi Mu**

Criteria:

- (1) Has served as an officer of an alumnae chapter, House Corporation or an Advisory Council
- (2) Has served the Fraternity as a National or Area Officer
- (3) Is a member of Phi Mu Foundation and Forever Faithful
- (4) Participates in a local alumnae chapter, where possible
- (5) Exemplifies Panhellenic spirit
- (6) Brings positive attention to Phi Mu through participation in professional and community organizations
- (7) Letter of support required
