

175,000 Service Hours

In celebration of Phi Mu's 175th Anniversary, we're coming together to make an extraordinary impact through service.

From July 4, 2026, through December 15, 2027, Phi Mu, members across the country are challenged to collectively complete 175,000 hours of service.

That's approximately five hours of service per member.

Whether you serve alongside your chapter, volunteer in your local community or give your time to an organization that matters to you, every hour brings us closer to our goal.

WHAT COUNTS AS A SERVICE HOUR?

We want members to serve in ways that are meaningful to them and their communities. If you are giving your time to help another person, organization or community without compensation, it can count toward our 175,000-hour goal.

WHEN DO SERVICE HOURS COUNT?

Service hours completed between July 4, 2026, and December 15, 2027, may be counted toward Phi Mu's 175,000 Service Hours commitment.

HOW TO TRACK YOUR SERVICE HOURS

Hours should be entered throughout the challenge period and submitted no later than December 15, 2027. How you record your hours will depend on your Phi Mu membership.

Collegiate Members

Collegiate members can record their individual service hours through myPhiMu or have hours tracked by chapter leadership.

Individual tracking:

1. Log in to myPhiMu and hover over your name in the top right corner
2. Once there, you will select "My Profile"
3. Select "Service Hours" on the left menu and then click "Add Service Hours"

4. Fill out the form
5. For "Affiliated Group," select your chapter
6. Once completed, click "Add Service Hours"

Officer tracking: This can only be done by the Chapter President, VP Administration, VP Community Engagement, Chapter Secretary or Chapter Philanthropy Chairwoman and must be done for chapter hosted events.

1. Log in to myPhiMu, and select your chapter in the top right corner
2. Once there, go to "View as: Chapter Officer" in the top left corner
3. Go to "Activity Tracker" and select "Service Hours"
4. Select "Track Chapter Service Hours" and fill out the form
5. Select "Add Collegians" and "Add Phis" and enter how many hours each type of member earned
6. Once completed, click "Submit"

Chapter leaders are encouraged to regularly remind members to record their hours so that every hour of service is represented in our national total.

Alumnae Members

Alumnae will report their individual service hours through their Profile on myPhiMu.

1. Log in to myPhiMu and hover over your name in the top right corner
2. Once there, you will select "My Profile"
3. Select "Service Hours" on the left menu and then click "Add Service Hours"
4. Fill out the form
5. If you are a member of an alumnae chapter, you can select your chapter in the "Affiliated Group" section
6. Once completed, click "Add Service Hours"

Alumnae chapters are encouraged to participate together and help ensure the service completed by all members is represented in our national total. Every alumna is invited to participate, regardless of whether she is currently involved with an alumnae chapter.
